

Together, they deliver integrated education, research, and community outreach aimed at improving healthcare access, advancing medical innovation, strengthening preventive care, and training skilled professionals. Their combined initiatives address physical, mental, and social well-being, with a focus on affordable healthcare, public health awareness, and sustainable practices that align with global health priorities.

3.3 Collaborations and Health Services

3.3.1 Collaboration

- Polio Surveillance & Clinical Research with NIV Mumbai & WHO: KIMS is part of a nationwide collaborative project (with 21 institutes) led by the National Institute of Virology (NIV), Mumbai, and supported by the World Health Organization (WHO). The project monitors poliovirus and other enteroviruses in patients with primary immunodeficiency.
- Tribal Tuberculosis Management with ICMR & NTEP: KIMS is partnering with the ICMR and National TB Elimination Programme (NTEP) on a "Comprehensive Tribal TB Management Programme" targeting tribal districts (e.g., Koraput) for decentralized TB care. The programme comes as one of the unique efforts which would help achieve our TB elimination target of 2025 and hence is projected for the next two years.
- Institute of Life Sciences (ILS), Bhubaneswar: Joint research on cancer and infectious diseases with KIMS.
- ICMR-RMRC (Bhubaneswar): MoU with KSPH & KIIT (2023) for joint research in public health, medical, and allied health sciences.






3.3.2 Community Outreach Program Promoting Health and Well-being Within and Beyond the University








Inspiring Blood Donation Camp on Gandhi Jayanti at Kalarabank




3.3.4 Free Sexual & Reproductive Health Care for KIIT Students

KIIT University, through its medical unit KIMS, provides confidential sexual and reproductive health services free of cost to all students. Appointments with trained consultants are available upon request, with all consultations handled discreetly initial screening and information are provided within the campus, and specialist referrals are made when needed.

Students can book an appointment with the consultants available with Kalinga Institute of Medical Sciences (the medical unit of the University) and discuss any issues they are facing or avail any related information. These services are provided free of cost to the University students.

3.3.5 Mental Health Care Services

KIIT University, supported by KIMS, offers free and confidential mental health care to all students & staffs:

- Counselling Cell: Free, confidential counselling for students, available both in-person and online via the SAP portal.
- Clinical Services at KIMS: Psychiatry department offers OPD, emergency care, and specialized clinics (adolescent guidance, dementia, substance cessation) with therapies like CBT, psychotherapy, and ECT.
- Capacity Building: Hostel staff trained in behavioral counselling to identify distress and provide timely support.
- Awareness & Engagement: Regular programmes, talks, and campaigns such as World Mental Health
 Day and Suicide Prevention Day, along with student-led initiatives, promote mental well-being across
 campus.
