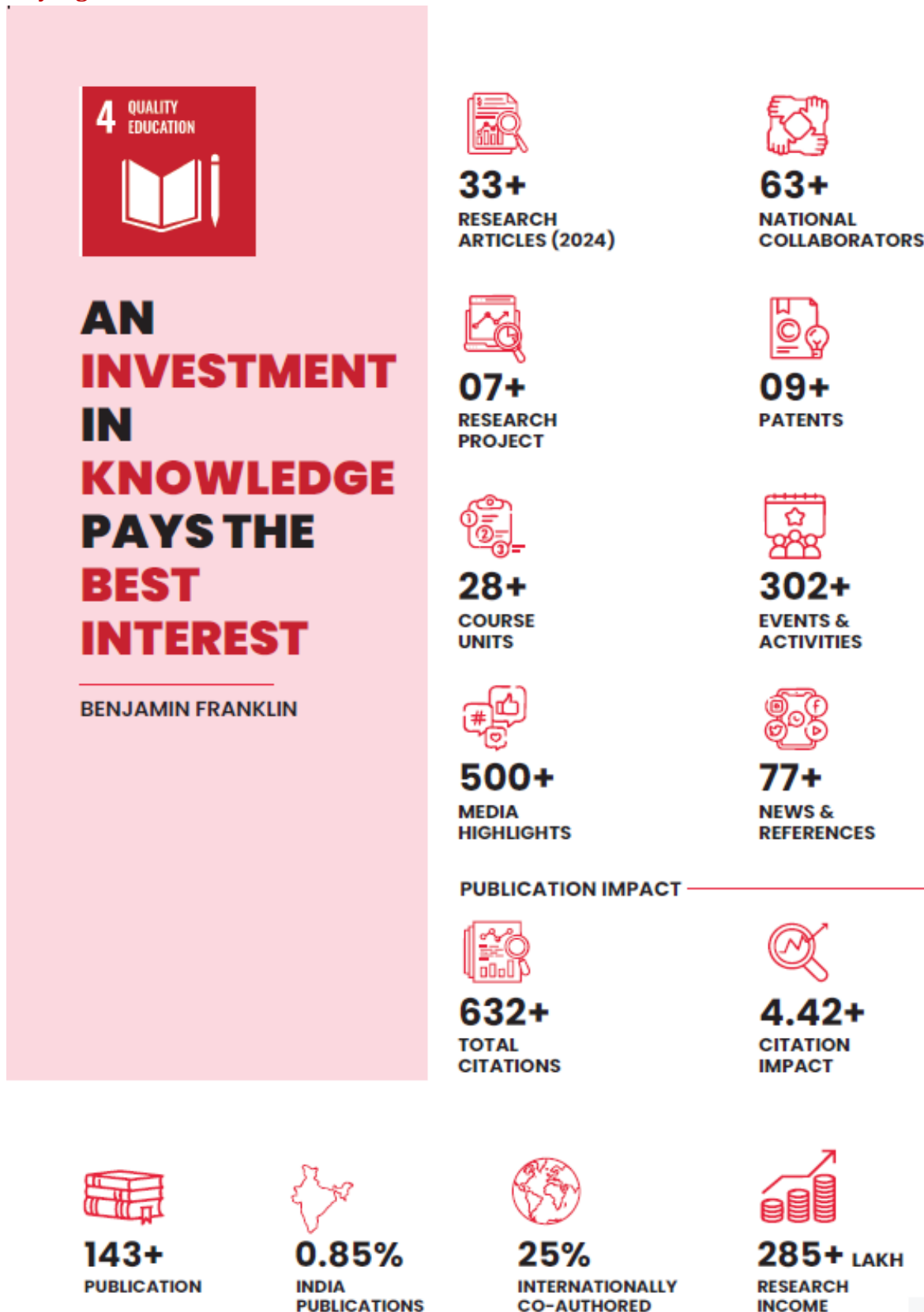
4. Introduction

Date and Venue: 15.01.2024 | KIMS

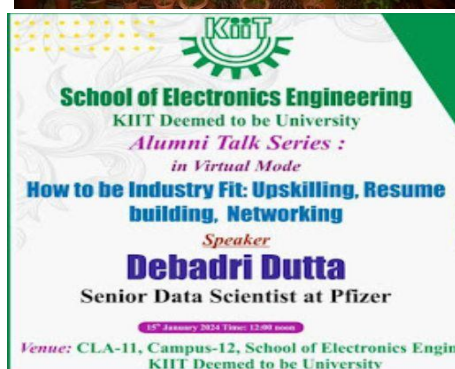

Date and Venue: 12.02.2024 | KIIT-DU

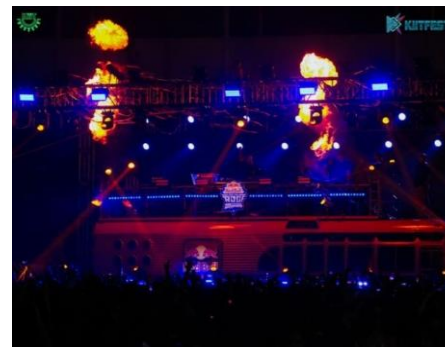

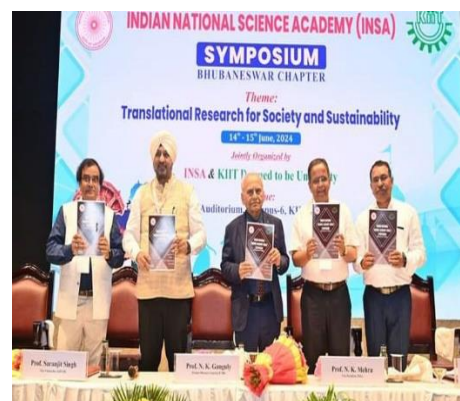

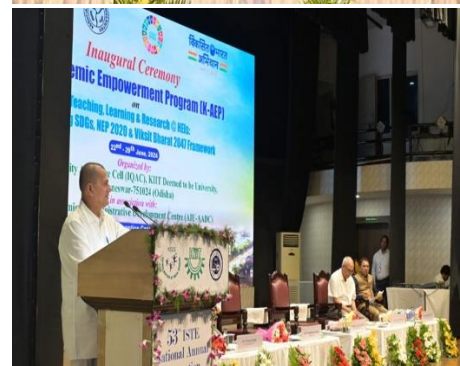

Date and Venue: 03.10.2024 | KIIT-DU

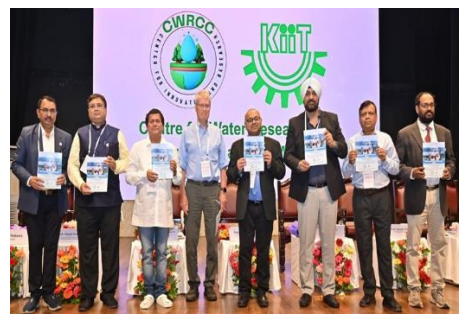

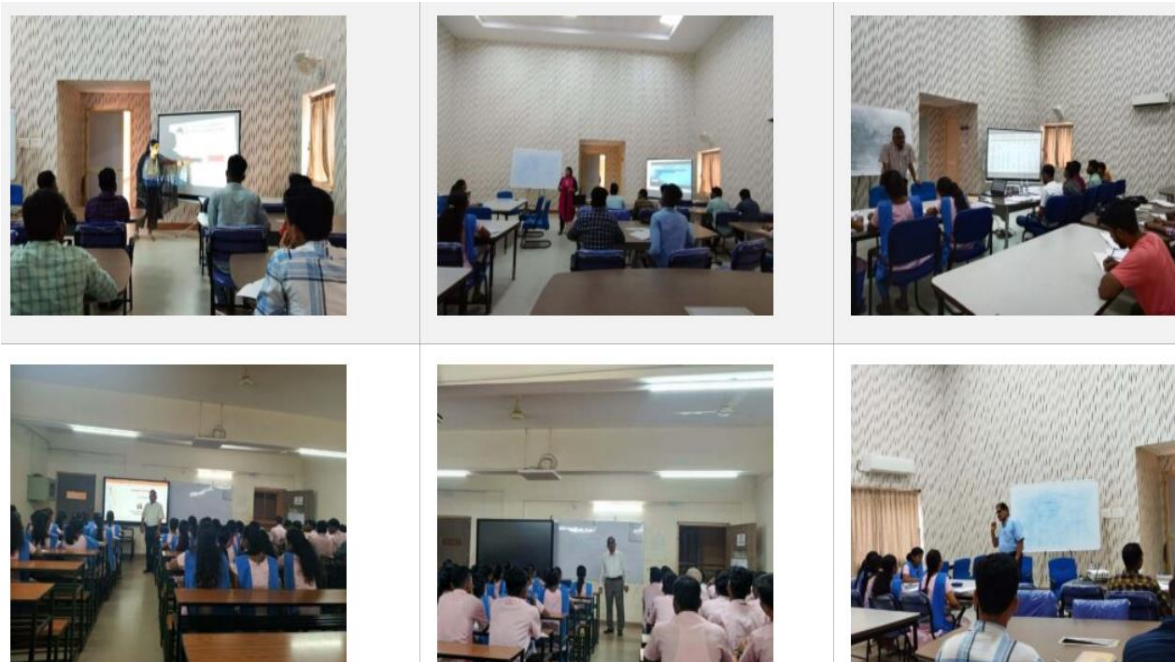
Within the academic framework of present syllabus approved by Govt of Odisha, the University helps the school in the following domains:

iii. Educating Tribal Students

KIIT University's staff and students actively support the initiatives of its sister institution, KISS, which is dedicated to eradicating poverty through education. KISS Bhubaneswar is a fully free, residential institution providing education from kindergarten to post-graduation for 30,000 underprivileged

tribal children, along with accommodation, meals, healthcare, and vocational training. Expanding its model of tribal empowerment, KISS aims to educate 200,000 children through branches across 10 states and 30 districts of Odisha. Operational centres include KISS Delhi (in partnership with the Delhi Government), Mayurbhanj, and Balasore, with new branches coming up in Kolkata (with Help Us Help Them), Bolangir (Oswal-KISS), and Baripada (Adani-KISS). The Emami-KISS Residential School also follows this holistic, free-education model, providing equal opportunities and comprehensive care for marginalized communities.

iv. Kanya Kiran- Empowering Women

Launched with UN Women and the Kalinga Fellowship, the *Kanya Kiran* program reached every Panchayat in Odisha, raising awareness on violence against women and girls. Over 3,000 KIIT staff, mainly women, led village-level campaigns promoting gender equality, hygiene, and environmental awareness.

In the year of 2024, National Girl Child Day and the International Day of Education were celebrated by 'Kanya Kiran' across 52 places including 30 district headquarters of Odisha.



v. Under Provision of Adoption of Villages and Panchayat

KIIT has evolved into a multidisciplinary institution offering education in Engineering, Medicine, Law, Management, Nursing, Biotechnology, Media, and Humanities. Guided by the ideals of the Radhakrishnan Commission, it promotes compassion, gender respect, and peace, while conducting various social development initiatives in education, employability, and related areas.

For instance, in the Kandhamal Parliamentary Constituency, KIIT facilitated employment for 7,000 rural youth and provided skill training to 15,000 more, partnering with 80 companies nationwide.



- vi. **KIIT Community Engagement Cell (CEC):** KIIT's CEC began its work in Kandhamal, an aspirational district with 75% ST/SC population, and has significantly contributed to rural development. The University has adopted 10 villages to transform them into smart, model villages through education and infrastructure support. Kalarabank in Cuttack, now a certified smart village, features city-like amenities such as schools, healthcare, banking, and telemedicine facilities.
- vii. **Prayash – Skill Training Programme:** Under the Prayash initiative, KIIT trains 150 unemployed tribal youths from Kandhamal annually in solar PV installation. In partnership with OTDS and OSFDC, KIIT provides skill training to SC/ST candidates across several Odisha districts, including Kalahandi, Kandhamal, and Mayurbhanj. So far, over 1,100 candidates have been trained, with around 75% successfully placed in industries within and outside the state.
- viii. **SPIC MACAY – KIIT Chapter (KSAC):** Established in 2003, the SPIC MACAY–KIIT Chapter promotes Indian classical music, dance, folk art, yoga, and crafts among youth. It has hosted renowned artists like Pt. Hari Prasad Chaurasia and Ileana Citaristi through free, open concerts celebrating India's rich cultural heritage. In 2023-24, the chapter also organized multiple social outreach activities focused on education, skill development, and community growth.

4.3.5 Lifelong Learning Access Policy:

KIIT University upholds an inclusive policy that guarantees equal access to all lifelong learning opportunities and educational resources. The University ensures that participation is open to everyone—regardless of caste, religion, gender, disability, ethnicity, immigration status, or any other background—reflecting its strong commitment to equity, diversity, and the principle of ‘Education for All.’

As per **Clause 16.1 of Memorandum of Association (MoA) of the University**, ‘Admission and Employment in the Deemed to be University shall be open to all, regardless of race, religion, caste or creed, disability, immigration status and the area/ place of residence in the world’. Besides, **Clause 16.2 of MoA of the University** also states that ‘All policies and procedures, in this regard as applicable to KIIT’.

Extract for Clause 3.1 of Human Resource Manual states that ‘In order to provide equal employment and advancement opportunities to all individuals, employment decisions at KIIT Deemed to be University will be based on merit, qualifications and abilities. KIIT does not discriminate in employment opportunities or practices on the basis of race, colour, religion, sex, national origin or disability. Employees with questions or concerns about discrimination in the workplace are encouraged to bring these issues to the attention of their supervisor. Employees can raise concerns and make reports without any fear. Anyone found to be engaging in unlawful discrimination will be subject to disciplinary action, including termination of employment.’

A. Anti-Corruption and Anti-Bribery Policy

- KIIT commits of zero tolerance towards fraudulent approaches including bribery
- Bribery of any sort shall not be paid or accepted from stakeholders, clients, suppliers, politicians, government / public official or general public etc for or on behalf of the University.
- Gifts or meals offered should be within normal civility.

- Also the Extract for Clause 11.10 'Gifts' of Human Resource Manual of the University states that 'in the discharge of his / her duties, no employee shall, except with the prior sanction of the competent authority, accept or permit his wife or any other member of his / her family to accept from any person other than relatives any gift of more than trifling value. The interpretation of the term 'trifling value' shall be the same as laid down in the Government Servants Conduct Rules'.
- This policy is applicable to all students, employees including senior management / directors of the University and third parties.
- Staff members are requested to report suspected violations of this Policy, and provide evidence of cases of bribery, corruption and manipulation; co-operate with any investigation or audit activities relating to matters covered by the Policy.
- Director Administration is responsible for monitoring compliance with this policy, reporting the breaches and providing solutions
- The contents of the Anti-Corruption and Bribery Policy will be reviewed on its effectiveness by the Internal Audit Department every two years and amendments if any required, may be made with the approval of the Board of Management.
